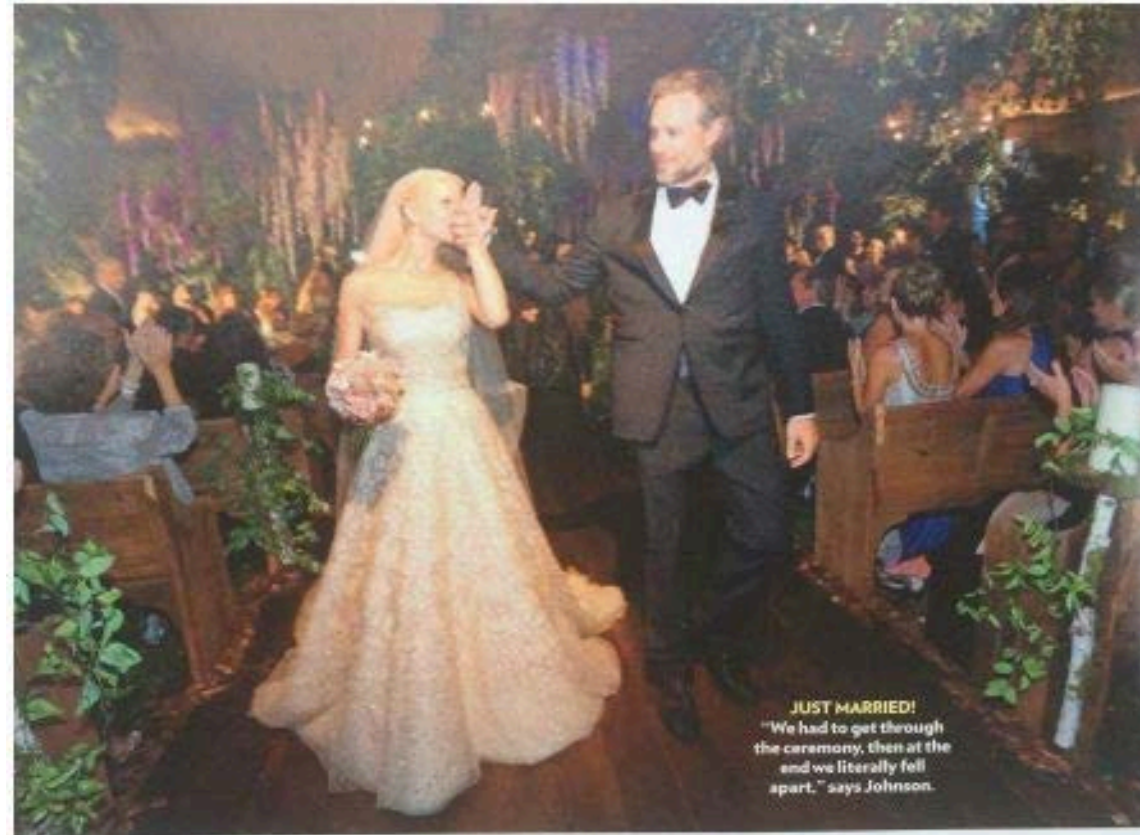

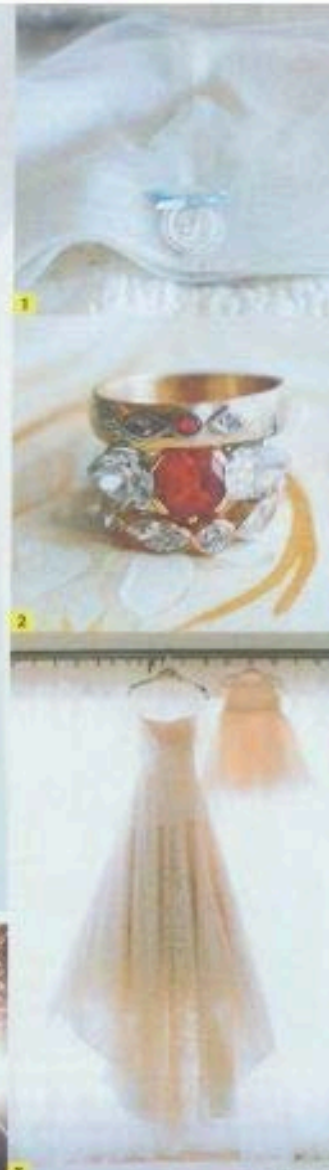
Johnson was left speechless when he first saw his fashion-mogul bride in her custom Carolina Herrera champagne gown with delicate gold embroidery.
